

Bradley Ferry Site (22 Acres)

A 22-acre riverside site owned by the Camden Area Industrial Development Corporation at the intersection of U.S. 79 North and Bradley Ferry Road and visible from U.S. 79 North. This site sits along the Ouachita River and was formerly owned by

International Paper as the site of a pump station to withdraw process water from the river and pipe it to IP's mill site. In prior years, it was the location of cotton warehouses and a dock for steam boats to take cotton down the river which is navigable to the Mississippi River. Currently, this site is accessible via Terminal Road through a residential section. The City has an engineered plan to build a new road access from Bradley Ferry Road.
